TriOptima AB selects Stockholm Waterfront for its new head office.

In June 2010 the financial technology company TriOptima AB is moving its head offices to the new Waterfront Building office complex – a part of Stockholm Waterfront.

The Waterfront Building continues to attract future-oriented companies that operate in the international market. Most recently TriOptima, as supplier of technology services to more than 150 of the world's largest financial institutions, has chosen Stockholm Waterfront - and the Waterfront Building in particular - as the site for its new head office. In June 2010 the company will move in to a wholly new floor equivalent to 2 100 m².

TriOptima has had a clear specification of requirements and the choice has been made in competition with other buildings.

"We are pleased that the Waterfront Building has risen to the challenge and that we can now welcome TriOptima to a building with high-performance office premises and a strong international profile," says Anders Henningsson of Jarl Asset Management.

In connection with this rental contract with TriOptima, more than one half of the office premises of the Waterfront Buildings are already let out and the interest in Waterfront Building continues at a high level.

"We can see that our concept is fully competitive and there is a requirement for just this type of office building represented by the Waterfront Building. Efficient and flexible office premises of high international standard, a central position and a very strong environmental profile. These are qualities that we know that our tenants demand," concludes Anders Henningsson.

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Jarl Asset Management, in collaboration with Jones Lang LaSalle, has been responsible for the letting at the same time as Tenant & Partner has represented TriOptima up to the signing of the lease. Tenant & Partner also represents TriOptima, through Anna Lundberg and Tenant & Partner Project, in the continued work until the move to the premises in question is completed.

The Waterfront Building is part of Stockholm Waterfront – Stockholm's new landmark with congress hall, hotel and offices. The Waterfront Building is a 12-storey state of the art environment profiled complex with a total of 24,300 square metres office space. It is situated in the very heart of Stockholm with views over Riddarfjärden and Stockholm City Hall.

TriOptima supplies services to companies active in trading with OTC derivatives. In nine years TriOptima has emerged as one of the world's foremost suppliers of post-trade services infrastructure to the global financial market. Company management and product development are located in Stockholm and sales offices in London, New York, Singapore and Tokyo.
